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### I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:-

1. a. Candidates seeking admission to Diploma in Nursing course for Women should upload their online filled in application form along with necessary enclosures before 5.00 pm on 12-08-2022.

- b. Request for extension of time for applying and uploading the documents after the specified date and time will not be considered.

- d. Candidates seeking admission under Special Category for Diploma in Nursing course for Women (Children of Ex-Servicemen Orthopaedically Physically Disabled and Eminent sports person) shall upload the prescribed format [(Annexure-I, II (A) & (B) and III (A),(B)&(C)].

- e. If the required certificate for special category are not uploaded the candidate will not be considered under special category. But they will be considered under general category only.

## II.ELIGIBILITY:-

2. The candidate should be a citizen of India and Native of Tamil Nadu.

## 3. NATIVITY:-

- a) Candidates belonging to other States cannot claim native of Tamil Nadu.

பிற மாநிலங்களைச் சேர்ந்த விண்ணப்பதாரர்கள் தமிழகத்தை பிறப்பிடமாகக் கோர முடியாது.

- b) Candidates who are Native of Tamil Nadu and who have studied 6<sup>th</sup> standard to 12<sup>th</sup> standard in schools of Tamil Nadu need not upload their "Nativity Certificate".

- c) Permanent Residence Certificate in Lieu of Nativity Certificate will not be accepted.

- d) Candidates who are Native of Tamil Nadu, but studied their education from 6<sup>th</sup> Standard to 12<sup>th</sup> standard either partly or completely in one or more states should upload their Nativity Certificate issued by the competent authority and true copies of their parent's certificates such as SSLC /10<sup>th</sup> Mark Sheet, 12<sup>th</sup> Mark Sheet, Transfer Certificate, Aadhar, Voter's ID, Driving License, Passport and Ration Card to substantiate their place of birth in Tamil Nadu, to ensure the relationship between the parent and candidate. If the supporting documents are not uploaded, then the online application will be summarily rejected.

- e) Candidates who are native of Tamil Nadu alone will be eligible for communal reservation.

- f) Other State candidates who are not native of Tamil Nadu but who have Studied 6<sup>th</sup> standard to 12<sup>th</sup> standard in Tamil Nadu will be treated as OC (Open Competition) candidate.

#### 4. GENDER:

- a) Only women candidates are eligible to apply Diploma in Nursing Course.

பெண் விண்ணப்பத்தாரர்கள் மட்டுமே செவிலியர் பட்டயப்படிப்பிற்கு விண்ணப்பிக்க தகுதியுடையவர்கள் ஆவர்.

- b) The Third Gender candidates who identify themselves as “Female” by self-declaration should upload their certificate (ID card) issued by the Tamil Nadu Third gender Welfare Board(TNTGWB) are also eligible to apply Diploma in Nursing Course.

#### 5. AGE LIMIT:-

Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022. (Those who were born few days later can also be included i.e. maximum 15 days).

## 6. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:-

- a) Candidates should have studied **“Tamil” as the first language.**
- b) Candidates should have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board /any other equivalent Board in the following group of subjects.
  - i. 65% of the seats will be filled up with candidates in the following subjects.
    - A. Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any other subject.
    - B. Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology.
  - ii. 25% of the seats will be filled up with candidates in the following subjects.
    - A. Vocational Nursing.
    - B. Foundation Science as Vocational subject.
  - iii. 10% of the seats will be filled with candidates in the subject not specified in items (i) and (ii) above.
- c) If adequate number of eligible candidates are not available in item ii and iii, the seats will be reverted back to item i.
- d) Candidates who have passed the HSC in Open University are not eligible to apply for Diploma in nursing course.

## 7. MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY MARKS:-

### a. For OC, BC, BCM & MBC/DNC Candidates:

A pass in HSC with 40% of aggregate of marks.

## 8. NORMALIZATION OF MARKS: -

As per the Tamil Nadu Act No.3 of 2007 dated 05.03.2007 and G.O. (Ms) No.77 HE (J2) Dept dated 05.04.2007, the marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the various Boards or Authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

### Explanation: -

Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.

### Illustration: -

If the highest mark secured by the student of State Board in Physics is 100 and the highest mark secured by a student of any other Board in the same subject is 90, both the highest mark will be considered to be equal to 100. If a student of the other Board secures 60 marks in Physics when the first mark in Physics in the same board is 90, then 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below:-

$$\frac{100 \times 60}{90} = 66.66\%$$

After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards will be merged into a common merit list.

In case of candidates who have qualified from National Boards such as CBSE and ISCE etc. the highest marks obtained by the candidates at the National Level alone will be taken into consideration for normalization.

## III. PROCEDURE FOR FILLING AND SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION:-

9. (a) (i) The candidate should log on in any one of the following websites:

- (ii) The fees for online application process is Rs.300/- and should be paid via bank portal.

- (iii) Candidates should upload their filled-in online application form by uploading the details in the required fields.

- (iv) Request for change in any particulars in the online application shall not be entertained under any circumstances after online submission.

- (v) Candidates are advised to upload only one application form. If a candidate uploads more than one application form, her candidature shall be cancelled.

- i. The candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe should upload their original Community Certificate obtained from a Competent Authority not below the rank of Revenue Divisional Officer. If candidate claims ST status in the online application without uploading the supporting documents for proper evidence, they will be treated as Open Competition Candidates.

- ii. Uploading a false community, Nativity or any other certificate if detected later at any point of time during the course of study will result in expulsion of the candidate and also criminal proceedings will be initiated against the candidate as well as the parents as per provision of law.

The concerned candidate and parents should take necessary steps to that effect. Unless proof of authenticity of community certificate is received, the candidate will not be allowed to continue the 2nd year.

- ii. The Third Gender candidates who belongs to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Caste (Arunthathiyar) / Scheduled Tribe communities, and possess community certificate as such, may be considered as per their respective community.
- iii. The Third Gender candidates who belong to the communities other than Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Caste (A) / Scheduled Tribe and possess community certificate as such (not covered under point (i) above) may be considered as per their own community or as Most Backward Class whichever is advantageous to them as per their option and once the individual exercises option for community selection it should be crystallized and this option should not be changed in future.
- iv. Community Certificate obtained from other States will not be considered and such candidates will be treated as open category

#### **12. CALCULATION OF MARKS:-**

Ranking will be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates. The marks obtained through different Boards will be taken into account after normalization.

- c) Any remaining reserved seats in ST Quota for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to ST community shall be allotted to candidates belonging to SC Community as per merit. (GO (Ms) No.77 Health & Family Welfare Department (MCA1) Dated 24.02.2011)
- d) Any remaining unfilled seats in BCM Community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled up on merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole (G.O.Ms.No.30/H&FW Dept(MCA1) Dated 18.01.2012)

- e) Even after filling up of the required seats reserved for Arunthathiyars on preferential basis, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, such excess number of candidates of Arunthathiyars shall be entitled to compete with the Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars in the inter-se merit among them (As per G.O.Ms.No.65, P & AR (K) Department, Dated:27.07.2009.

**VII. CATEGORIES OF SEATS:-**

26. Students will be admitted under the following categories on merit basis.

Category - I Stipendiary

Category - II Stipendiary (TAHDCO)

(For SC/SCA/ST/SC converted Christians only)

The stipend will be paid as follows for the students admitted in Diploma in Nursing course from 2021-2022 session as per G.O.Ms. No.34/H&FW (PME) Dept. Dated: 07.02.2014.

First Year : Rs. 600/- per month

Second Year : Rs. 700/- per month

Third Year : Rs. 800/- per month

Rs.800/- shall be paid for the period of internship training. The rate of Stipend is liable to be revised at any time without prior notice.

**27. SPECIAL CATEGORIES: -**

- i. Seats earmarked for the Special Categories will be allotted by following the Horizontal Reservation. The Seats will be allotted as per merit order in the concerned special category and those seats will be deducted in the concerned compartment (OC / BC / BCM / MBC / DNC/ SC / SCA / ST) and the remaining seats will be allotted to the General Category.
- ii. If adequate numbers of eligible candidates are not available under Special Category the earmarked seats will be reverted back to general category.
- iii. The other eligibility conditions for admission will be applicable in the case of General Category

**28. SEATS RESERVED FOR CHILDREN OF EX-SERVICEMEN:**

(No of seats reserved: 57)

The candidate should furnish a certificate as prescribed in the Format in Annexure-I obtained from the competent authority. The Special Committee from the defence authorities constituted for this purpose will scrutinize certificates submitted by the candidates. Eligible candidates will be selected on merit basis.

**4.(a) For International Tournaments:**

**Category – I:** Olympics, World Cup / Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, (Games organized in 4 years frequency by the International Olympic Committee).

**Category – II :** A minimum of six countries must have been participated for International tournaments which are not covered under Category I, and such tournaments approved by Indian Olympic Association ((IOA), Sports Authority of India (SAI) and Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS), Government of India.
