(Ms.) No. 30 H & FW Dept. dated 18.01.2012). Hence BC candidates can register and choice lock for BCM seats also.

For Reported Candidates in 1st round of counseling

All India Quota Round II counselling are not allowed to vacate the seat. On similar ground the candidates who have joined in Round II of State counselling will not be permitted to vacate/resign/surrender the seat.

- > The candidates who have taken admission in second round of allotment or carry the seat allotted in first round beyond notified date, which is not upgraded in second round, will not be permitted to vacate the seat.
- > The candidates who fall into these above categories are not eligible to participate in mop up / subsequent round of counselling.
- > The candidates who have been allotted in mop up round of All India Quota/Deemed university/DNB (conducted by NBE) are **not eligible to** participate in state mop up counselling and Stray Vacancy round.

In order to prevent the seat blocking:

If a candidate is getting an allotment in this mop up counselling, he/she cannot claim a seat in mop up counselling for MD/MS courses in Government Medical College /Government quota seats in Self financing colleges and Management mop up counselling.
