(Ms.) No. 77 H & FW Dept. dated 24.02.2011).**Hence SC candidates can register and choice lock for ST seats also.**
 - As mentioned in MDS Government Prospectus clause 31(c) Any remaining unfilled seats in BCM community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled up on merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole(G.O. (Ms.) No. 30 H & FW Dept. dated 18.01.2012).**Hence BC candidates can register and choice lock for BCM seats also.**
