  - \* Candidates participating by ONLINE COUNSELLING for PG DEGREE/DIPLOMA course will have to remit a non-refundable amount of Rs. 1000/- as processing fee through online by using a Debit Card /Net Banking or Credit Card. The candidates who have already paid processing fee need not pay again.
