NOTIFICATION

As per orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.A. Nos. 1051, 1117 to 1124 of 2018, dated 17.05.2018, the Government have constituted an expert Committee under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Justice Thiru.A.Selvam, (Retd.), High Court of Madras, to identify remote / difficult / rural areas for awarding incentive marks to the in-service Medical Officers for the admission to Post Graduate Degree / Diploma Courses from the academic year 2019 – 2020, vide G.O.(Ms).No.536 Health and Family Welfare (MCA-1) dated 15.11.2018. The Chairmanship who gave his recommendations for awarding incentive marks to the in-service Medical Officers as provided in the clause 9(iv) of the Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000. After detailed examination, the Government have decided to accept the recommendation of the Committee and orders have been issued in G.O.Ms.No.86, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 6.3.2019 and amendment in G.O.(Ms).No.114, H&FW Dept, dated 29.03.2019. As per the order of Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P.Nos.8071, 8254, 8318 and 8474 of 2019 dated 27.03.2019, the expert Committee has to revisit to identify the Remote/ Difficult/ Rural areas for awarding incentive marks to the in-service candidates for admission to Post Graduate Degree/Diploma courses, vide G.O.(Ms).No. 152, H & FW Dept dated 29.04.2019.

The stakeholders, if interested in the re-classification of the areas should submit their representations in the prescribed format furnished in the official websites to "The Additional Director of Medical Education/ Secretary, Selection Committee, No. 162, Periyar E.V.R.High Road, Kilpauk, Chennai-10 so as to reach **on or before 31.05.2019 by 5.00pm**.
