2. Due to outbreak of pandemic n-COVID19 the Government of India have announced Lock-down from 24.03.2020 6.00 PM to 03.05.2020 to prevent from spreading of the n-COVID19. Moreover, in the reference second read above the DGHS, New Delhi have issued a notice to the State Counseling Authorities to conduct their State Counselling from 20th April to 04th May 2020.

3. In his letter 3rd read above, the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee has stated that conducting of Offline Counselling will not be possible in view of the pandemic and requested necessary orders of the Government amending the existing orders for conducting Online Counselling.

4. The Government after careful consideration accepts the proposal of the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee. Accordingly, the Government hereby issues the following amendments to the G.O.(D).No.318, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 11.03.2020:-

AMENDMENTS

Among the clauses and sub-clauses stated in annexure to the G.O.(D).No.318, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 11.03.2020, the following shall be substituted:

"18.(a) (i) Admission to PG Degree / Diploma courses, shall be made by the ONLINE COUNSELLING on the basis of rank by applying the rule of reservation. The detailed online counseling procedures are available in Annexure.

(ii) A Candidate who has not registered and choice locking in the 1st round of ONLINE COUNSELLING will not be permitted to the subsequent rounds of ONLINE COUNSELLING. (i.e. second round and mop-up round).

(iii) A candidate who has taken a seat and not joined (in person or through e-mail) the course, he / she is not eligible to the subsequent rounds of ONLINE COUNSELLING.

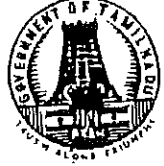

ORDER :

In the Government order first read above, the Government have approved the Policy / Prospectus for admission to MDS course under Management quota including NRI Seats in Self-Financing Dental colleges in Tamil Nadu for the academic year 2020-2021 session.

2. Due to outbreak of pandemic n-COVID19 the Government of India have announced Lock-down from 24.03.2020 6.00 PM to 03.05.2020 to prevent from spreading of the n-COVID19. Moreover, in the reference second read above the DGHS, New Delhi have issued a notice to the State Counseling Authorities to conduct their State Counselling from 20th April to 04th May 2020.

3. In his letter 3rd read above, the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee has stated that conducting of Offline Counselling will not be possible in view of the pandemic and requested necessary orders of the Government amending the existing orders for conducting Online Counselling.

4. The Government after careful consideration accepts the proposal of the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee. Accordingly, the Government hereby issues the following amendments to the G.O.(D).No.321, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 11.03.2020:-

AMENDMENTS

Among the clauses and sub-clauses stated in annexure to the G.O.(D).No.321, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 11.03.2020, the following shall be substituted:

" 15 (a) (i) Admission to MDS courses, shall be made through ONLINE COUNSELLING. The detailed online counseling procedures are available in Annexure.

(ii) A Candidate who have not registered and choice locking in the 1st round of ONLINE COUNSELLING will not be permitted to the subsequent rounds of ONLINE COUNSELLING. (i.e. second round and mop-up round).

(iii) A candidate who has taken a seat and not joined (in person or through e-mail) the course, he / she is not eligible to the subsequent rounds of ONLINE COUNSELLING.

(b) Re-allotment is permitted during the subsequent phases of ONLINE COUNSELLING only, based on Rank and Rule of Reservation.

16. Candidates selected for admission should give a self-declaration form at the time of the reporting (through Physical / Online) to the concerned Dental College. He / she is liable for forfeiture of selection / admission if suppression of facts mis-interpretation is found at any time during or after the admission to the course.

18. The candidates should download their provisional allotment order and join the course in the concerned Dental College on or before the date and time stipulated during the first phase of ONLINE COUNSELING by following the two modes

(A). PHYSICAL REPORTING:

The candidates should produce their original certificates in person at the time of joining in their selected Dental Colleges along with the scanned copy of original certificates to the concerned Dental Colleges.

(B). ONLINE REPORTING:

The candidate can join the allotted Dental College by sending a confirmatory email regarding acceptance of seat and uploading scanned copies of relevant documents.

In view of the above the participating candidates are instructed as follows:

If a seat is allotted to a candidate he/she may join the allotted seat availing any of the above two options (Physical / Online Reporting). The following documents are required for Physical / Online Reporting (for uploading) for verification by the College authorities:

- (a) (i) NEET MDS 2020-Score Card.
(ii) NEET MDS 2020 Admit Card.
- (b) Aadhar card
- (c) BDS Degree Certificate or Provisional Pass Certificate.
- (d) CRRRI Completion Certificate.
- (e) Permanent Dental Registration Certificate issued by the Dental Council of India /State Dental Council or provisional Registration Certificate issued by the Dental Council of India/State Dental Council.
- (f) Community Certificate issued by the competent authority indicating the community status of candidates belonging to Backward Community/Backward Community (Muslim)/ Most Backward Community / Denotified Communities/ Schedule Caste/ Schedule Caste (Arunthathiyar).
Scheduled Tribe candidates should produce community certificates issued by a Revenue Divisional Officer of the competent jurisdiction.
- (g) For Service Candidates.
TNPSC/MRB (through competitive written examination) Selection & Posting Order
- (h) Eligibility Certificate, if applicable.
- (i) A copy of receipt of payment.

Candidates are instructed to produce the above mentioned original Certificates/ Documents at the time of counselling for certificate verification.

- (j) Same photo of that uploaded in NEET MDS 2020 must be uploaded in filled-in online application.
 - (k) Post Card size colour photograph (4"x6") (size: 50kb to 300kb) of the same photo that has been uploaded in NEET MDS 2020 to be uploaded.
21. (a) All candidates participating by ONLINE COUNSELLING for MDS Courses will have to remit a non-refundable amount of ₹ 1000/- through online as processing fee and the fee should be remitted by using a Debit Card or Credit Card.
- (b) (i) The candidates who are selected at the time of ONLINE COUNSELLING should pay an amount of ₹ 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only) as tuition fee by way of Debit Card / Credit Card/ Net Banking.

- (ii) The tuition fee is not refundable if the candidate does not join after collecting the provisional allotment order in second round of ONLINE COUSSELLING .
22. Second round of ONLINE COUNSELLING will be applicable only for those who have joined/waitlisted candidates of first round of ONLINE COUNSELLING and the candidates in the rank list as per the counselling schedule mentioned in the official website.
23. a) After completion of second round of ONLINE COUNSELLING if there is any vacancy that will be filled by mop-up round.
- (b) The vacancies arising after re-allotment will be filled up with the candidates from the Rank list by ONLINE COUNSELLING (if time permits as per DGHS Schedule).
