PREAMBLE:

As per the direction of the Directorate General of Health Services Secretary, Selection Committee O/o. Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai inviting application for Super Speciality course for in-service candidates of Tamil Nadu. In-service doctors who entered in Tamil Nadu Government Service through TNPSC/MRB alone are eligible to apply. In this regard orders have been issued in G.O.(Ms) No. 462, Health and Family Welfare (MCA-1) department, dated 07.11.2020 to reserve 50% of seats in super Speciality during the year 2020-2021 session against which a case was filed before Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.No.12891/2020. Based on the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Government Order was put on hold. Further, the Petitioner filed a W.P (C).No.53 of 2022 and the Hon'ble Supreme court upheld the validity of Government Order in its order dated 16.03.2022 & 22.03.2022 and allowed 50 % seat reservation for in-Service candidates of Tamil Nadu Medical Services.

2. Based on the above Judgments, the Directorate General of health Services, New Delhi has asked Government of Tamil Nadu to conduct counselling for 50% of in-Service Candidates to Super Speciality course for 2021-2022 vide D.O. letter No.5233/MCA-1/2022-3, dated 31.03.2022.

3. Accordingly, the Selection Committee, Government of Tamil Nadu has been entrusted to conduct the counselling for in-service candidates of Super Speciality course for 2021-2022.

I.GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.(a) (i) In service Candidates seeking admission to Super Speciality Course 2021-2022 session in Tamil Nadu Government Medical Colleges can access / download the application from the following websites:

www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in

www.tnmedicalselection.org

- (ii) In service Candidates should submit their filled-in online application form after uploading the details in the required fields. (Details of filling and submission of Application form is available in Annexure - I)

(iii) **METHOD OF FEE PAYMENT:**

Method of payment of Rs.5000/- (Non-refundable) through Debit Card, Credit Card/ Net Banking:

- Necessary facilities have been provided for making payment through nationalized banks via bank payment portal.
- Candidates must note that mere deduction of fee from the Bank account is not a proof of fee payment.
- Check the validity of the Debit/Credit Card/ Net banking and keep it ready with you while logging on to the website for submitting application form. Candidate should enter the information asked for and make payment through Debit/ Credit Card.

- (iv) In Service Candidates should take the print out of the online application form and attach their service particulars along with the filled-in online application forms. (Duly certified by the Forwarding Authority with date and seal).

- (v) The last date for submission of online application form will be upto 05:00 P.M. on 09.04.2022, thereafter candidates cannot submit their online application form.

- (vi) Submission of print out of filled in online application form received after 05:00 P.M. on 11.04.2022 will be rejected summarily.

- (b) Medical Officers working in any Government Institution should get their filled-in online Service Proforma and application form forwarded only through the proper channel with

the remarks of the Forwarding Authorities in the format prescribed in the application form. Otherwise the application will be summarily rejected.

- (c) Candidates seeking admission under Special Category should submit a separate Special Category Form – I (PwD refer in the clause 29) provided in the prospectus and enclose a Photo copy of the recent (within 3 months) Medical certificate issued by the Regional Medical Board along with the printout of their online application.
- (d) If the photocopies of the Medical certificates are not enclosed, then the special category candidates' application will be considered under the general category only.

II.ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 2. (a) Candidates should be Citizens of India.
- (b) Candidates must be an in-service candidate of Tamil Nadu and their service should be regularized.
- (c) The candidates who are native of Tamil Nadu, had done MBBS and PG are eligible to apply.
- (d) Candidates seeking admission in Super Speciality Courses, they have to qualify the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test-NEET SS 2021 conducted by the National Board of Examination. The eligibility criteria prescribed by the Director General of Health Services, Government of India, New Delhi, in accordance with Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations (as per latest amendment) notified by Board of Governors, In supersession of the National Medical Commission with prior approval of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi shall be taken into account for admission to Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu for the academic year 2021-2022.

III. NON ELIGIBILITY

- 3. (a) Candidates who joined a Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu in any Branch and discontinue the course on any grounds on or after the cut off date as per the guidelines of National Medical Council, should pay the Discontinuation Fee as per Clause 21(c) of this Prospectus.

(b) The candidates who take allotments for Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu in any branch in the final round of counselling must join the courses, if not, there will be forfeiture of tuition fee.

4. Candidates who are undergoing a Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu are not eligible to apply for any Super Speciality Courses in Tamil Nadu.

5. Candidates who have already completed a Super Speciality Course /Equivalent Courses are not eligible to apply for admission to any other Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu.

6. Non Service Candidates are not eligible to apply for admission to Super Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu.

“Candidates working in Institutions coming under “Registered Societies Act” and “Self Financing Institutions” shall be considered as Non Service candidates.”

IV.SERVICE CANDIDATES

The candidates who were working in Tamil Nadu Government Institutions / Local bodies and appointed through TNPSC / MRB through special qualifying examination in the Tamil Nadu Medical services should have minimum two years service as on 31.03.2022 is treated as service candidates.

7) (a) The following categories of Medical Officers will be treated as Service Candidates for the purpose of allotment of seats:

Medical Officers selected by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission (TNPSC)/Medical Services Recruitment Board (MRB) through Competitive Written Examination/Special Qualifying Examination and appointed in Tamil Nadu Medical Services should have minimum Two Years of continuous service, as on 31.03.2022.

(b) Candidates who have been temporarily appointed but not qualified through Written Examination conducted by TNPSC/MRB and who have not completed two years of

continuous service as on 31.03.2022 as per clause 7 (a) (i) of this prospectus, are not eligible to apply for Higher Speciality Course 2021-2022 session. If any applications received from such candidates or even if forwarded inadvertently by the competent authority that application will be summarily rejected.

(c) Competent authorities who are forwarding the applications of Government Medical officers have to issue a complete Service Particular Proforma including their leave and deputation in detail. The print out of filled in online application with service particulars should reach within the stipulated time.

(d) Online Application received after the last date will not be accepted irrespective of the date of submission and date of forwarding by the competent authority.

V. PROCEDURE FOR FILLING & SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION:

8.a) (i) The candidate should log on in any one of the following websites :

The application forms will be available between 07.04.2022 and upto 05.00 P.M on 09.04.2022.

(ii) Candidates should submit their filled-in online application form by uploading the details in the required fields.

(iii) Request for change in any particulars in the online Application shall not be entertained under any circumstances after submission.

(iv) Incomplete applications will be rejected.

(v) Candidates are advised to submit only one Application Form. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form, his/her candidature will be cancelled.

(vi) Candidates should ensure that all information entered in the online application are correct during the online submission of application form. If found that the candidate has given the wrong information then the application will be rejected. If found after the admission then the said candidate will be withdrawn from the grant of seat and

will be treated as discontinued seat as per the clause 20 of the prospectus.

(vii) Service Candidates should submit the print out of the filled-in online application forms along with their Service particulars (Duly certified by the Forwarding Authority with date and seal) and necessary enclosures.

(c) In-service candidates should send their filled-in online application form along with all the enclosures in an A4 size cloth lined cover. The template with the requisite details should be printed and pasted on the cover.

(d) AR Number (Application Registration Number) will be assigned by the Selection Committee on receipt of the filled-in online applications.

9. The Government Orders issued and to be issued from time to time pertaining to any of the matters contained in this prospectus should be read as part and parcel of this Prospectus and such terms and conditions in the Government Order are deemed to have been incorporated in this Prospectus.

10. Candidates must enclose only Self attested Photocopies of required Certificates/documents:

(a) (i) NEET SS 2021-Score Card.

(ii) NEET SS 2021 Admit Card.

(b) MBBS Degree Certificate and Post Graduate Degree Certificate or Provisional Pass Certificate.

(c) Permanent Medical Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India /State Medical Council or provisional Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India/State Medical Council.

(d) TNPSC/MRB (through competitive written examination) Selection & Posting Order.

(e) Recent Regional Medical Board Certificate for Person with Disabilities.

- (f) Eligibility Certificate obtained from TN Dr.MGR Medical University – candidates who did Broad Speciality PG in other Universities.
- (g) Same photo of that uploaded in NEET SS 2021 must be uploaded in filled-in online application.
- (h) Post Card size colour photograph (4"x6") (size: 50kb to 300kb) to be uploaded.
- (i) **Aadhar Card/Pan Card/Voter ID**
Candidates are instructed to produce the above mentioned original Certificates/ Documents at the time of admission.

11. (a) Incomplete filled-in online application, application submitted without the proper documents and application forms without the signature of the candidates will be summarily rejected.

(b) The candidate who takes allotment should register in Tamil Nadu Medical Council and produce Registration certificate at the time of joining the Course in the respective college.

(c) All the guidelines issued by Medical Counselling Committee and Director General of Health Service will be applicable then and there.

VI. RANK LIST

12. The Rank list will be drawn based on marks obtained in NEET SS -2021.

13. The Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the tentative Rank List on the following official websites after completion of scrutiny of all applications received for this academic year 2021-2022.

VII.COUNSELLING PROCEDURES :

14. Offline counselling will be conducted as per National Medical commission guidelines and it will be updated in the websites then and there.

OFFLINE COUNSELLING:

15.(a) (i) Admission to Super Specialty Course in Tamil Nadu, shall be made OFFLINE COUNSELLING on the basis of Merit only and no communal reservation will be followed.

(ii) A candidate who has taken a seat and not joined /discontinued the course within the stipulated time in the first round of counseling, he/she is eligible to attend the further rounds of COUNSELLING.

(b) Mutual transfer/ Individual request for transfer of college will not be permitted under any circumstances.

16. Candidates selected for admission should give a self-declaration form at the time of the reporting to the concerned Medical College that he/She is liable for forfeiture of selection/admission if suppression of facts or mis-interpretation is found at any time during or after the admission to the course.

17. If any suppression of facts is found later, the selection / admission will be liable for cancellation during or after the admission to the course based on the declaration. Further, he/she will not be allowed to apply for the Super Speciality Courses for subsequent two academic years.

18 The candidates should produce the following original certificates at the time of joining in their selected Medical College along with the scanned copy of original certificates to the concerned Medical Colleges.

(a) (i) NEET SS 2021-Score Card.

(ii) NEETSS 2021 Admit Card.

(b) MBBS Degree Certificate and Post Graduate Degree Certificate or Provisional Pass Certificate.

(c) Permanent Medical Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India /State Medical Council or provisional Registration Certificate issued by the Medical Council of India/State Medical Council.

(d) TNPSC/MRB (through competitive written examination) Selection & Posting Order.

(e) Recent Regional Medical Board Certificate for Person with Disabilities.

- (f) Eligibility Certificate.
- (g) A copy of receipt of payment.

Candidates are instructed to produce the above mentioned original Certificates/ Documents at the time of admission.

- (h) Same photo of that uploaded in NEET SS 2021 must be uploaded in filled-in online application.
- (i) Post Card size colour photograph (4"x6") (size: 50kb to 300kb) to be uploaded.

(j) Aadhar Card/Pan Card/Voter ID

19. Any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available only on the following official websites:

The candidates are instructed to visit the websites frequently from the date of submission of application till the end of the admission process.

20. Unauthorized absence of candidates for fifteen days after joining the course will be treated as 'discontinued' and that vacancy will be filled up by the Selection Committee depending on the availability of time as per National Medical Commission guideline. If the period of absence is beyond the second round of counselling, the candidate must pay the discontinuation fee as per clause 21(c) of this prospectus.

- 21.(a) Candidates Participating in COUNSELLING for Super Speciality Course will have to remit a non-refundable amount of ₹ 1000/- as processing fee by the Demand Draft drawn in the favour of Secretary, Selection Committee payable at Chennai -10.

- (b) Tuition fee as per clause (30) has to be paid through Demand Draft in favour of Secretary , Selection Committee payable at Chennai -10 at the time of receiving allotment order. Tuition Fee paid at the time of receiving provisional allotment order is non-refundable, if the candidate does not join or discontinues the course.

(c) (i) Allotted in-service candidates who discontinue the course on or after the stipulated time should pay the Discontinuation Fees besides foregoing tuition fees already paid by them as specified in Clause 21 (c) (ii) & Clause 30 , to the Deans of the respective Colleges, the sum as specified below in total by means of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Secretary, Selection Committee, Kilpauk, Chennai – 10”, payable at Chennai.

(ii) Allotted in-service candidates who discontinue the course on or after the stipulated time should pay the Discontinuation Fees as mentioned below besides foregoing tuition fees already paid by them as specified in Clause 30, to the Deans of the respective Colleges, the sum as specified in total by means of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Secretary, Selection Committee, Kilpauk, Chennai – 10”, payable at Chennai.

For Super Speciality Course - Rs.20 Lakhs

Unless the aforesaid discontinuation fee as penalty amount is paid in total, the candidates will not be relieved and original certificates produced by the candidates at the time of admission will be retained by the concerned institutions.

Further rounds of counselling will be updated through website then and there.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS :-

24. If the candidates discontinue the course after a stipulated date, they will have to forfeit the tuition fee paid by them. Provided that the candidates who have discontinued their course on or after last date of admission should pay the penalty as mentioned in the Clause 21(c) (ii) of this Prospectus.
25. The admissions will close on xx-xx-2022 as per the guidelines issued by the Board of Governors, In supersession of the National Medical Commission, Director General of Health Service and the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Guindy, Chennai-600032.

VIII. METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

26. (a) Seats in Government Medical Colleges University: Out of the seats sanctioned for Higher Speciality Courses 50% of the total recognized / permitted seats are offered to All India Quota for allotment by the Director General of Health Services, New Delhi. The remaining 50% of the seats will be allotted for inservice candidates in State Quota quota.

(b) As per G.O. (Ms.) No. 462 Health and family Welfare (MCA-1) Department dated 07.11.2020, 50% of the in-service Super Speciality seats would be filled up based on the marks obtained in the NEET SS.

Candidates are advised to go through the respective college websites and satisfy themselves regarding National Medical Commission approvals, infrastructure and the rules and regulations.

27. (a) Allotment will be made only for the seats affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University and for the Academic Year 2021-2022 session. Seats approved by the respective University for Higher Speciality Course in Tamil Nadu for 2021-2022 session will be displayed before the counseling.

(b) Some seats for which **National Medical Commission** has issued letter of permission (LOP), may not be recognized by the **National Medical Commission** for the current academic year.

28. The Selection Committee will not be responsible for **National Medical Commission approvals, infrastructure and the rules and regulations of the concerned Medical Colleges. Hence, candidates are advised to go through the respective college websites and satisfy themselves before giving their option for selection of seats by the candidate during counselling. The Selection Committee shall neither be responsible nor shall entertain any case on the above grounds.**

IX.SPECIAL CATEGORY

29. SEATS RESERVED FOR PERSON WITH DISABILITIES:

- (a) 5% of the total number of seats available in Government Medical Institutions are reserved for the Person with disabilities.
- (b) (i) Candidates with disabilities of 40-80 % may be considered eligible.
(ii) Candidates with more than 80% disabilities - NOT ELIGIBLE.
(iii) Candidates with less than 40% disabilities -NOT ELIGIBLE for reservation under PwD, but eligible under General Category.

As per “ANNEXURE-A” published by the **National Medical Commission** in pursuance of the communication from Ministry of Health and family Welfare as follows:

“Presence of significant Locomotor Disability with or without any other significant disability such as Visual or hearing–speech or learning etc. which will make it very difficult for the candidate to pursue and complete the course satisfactorily and may significantly increase the risk to the candidate or the patient(s) – may be declared NOT ELIGIBLE for admission”.

- (c) The candidates are required to produce a certificate obtained from the Regional Medical Board constituted at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai-600 003 for the purpose of assessing the nature and the extent of disability. The Certificate must have been obtained within three months prior to submitting the application for seeking admission under this category. If the Certificate has been obtained earlier, then the application will be rejected. If the candidate fails to submit the Medical Certificate for Person with disabilities then their application will be rejected.
- d) The candidates seeking admission under this special category should produce a full size recent photograph (taken within three months) exhibiting the deformity.

X. TUITION FEE

30. Fees payable in Government Institutions:

The above fee structure is applicable for 2021-2022 admissions. The selected candidates have to pay any balance of the Tuition Fee (if any) and other special fees etc., at the time of admission in their respective colleges.”

XI.STIPEND AND SECURITY AMOUNT

31 (a) Service Candidates will be paid salary as per the Government Orders issued by Government from time to time, if the candidates selected for Super Speciality Courses in the Government Medical Colleges.

(b) The Government of Tamil Nadu is offering Super Speciality through its Medical Colleges / Hospitals and The Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University / Specialized institutes. The Government spends a large amount of money to impart Medical Education including Super Speciality Medical Education. It levies nominal fees and at the same time provides stipend to Private candidates and salary to Service candidates. It is natural that the Government desires to ensure that these seats are not wasted. Further, the Government looks forward to these Doctors who have undergone Post-Graduate training to serve the poor and the needy of this country at large and this State in particular. The public have the right to expect the Specialists to utilize the skills they acquired during their training for the benefit of the sick, the poor and the needy. To ensure that the services of trained Post Graduate Doctors are made available, an Undertaking is obtained from them at the time of their admission. It is sincerely, believed that this will discourage an attitude of not paying attention to those poor people at whose expense they have been educated.

(c) All Service Candidates of Tamil Nadu having more than two years of service after completing the Super Speciality Courses shall execute a bond for a sum of ₹50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakh only) as security amount with the undertaking that they will serve the Government of Tamil Nadu till Superannuation with three sureties. Two sureties should be

from permanent Government employee in the same or higher rank than the candidate. One surety should be from the spouse/ parent of the candidate. PAN numbers of the sureties should be furnished. The prescribed form of bond is enclosed in Annexure IV. The bond will become infructuous if the service candidates serve the Government of Tamil Nadu after the completion of the Course until superannuation.

(d) All service candidates of Tamil Nadu who have less than 5 years of service after completing their Super Speciality courses, have to serve the Government for a period of 2 years from the date of Clearing the examination irrespective of the date of superannuation, if the Government requires their services. They have to furnish an undertaking to this effect at the time of joining the course.

(e) The Security bonds are governed by Clause (c) under exemption under Article 57 of Schedule – I of the Indian Stamp Act of 1879 (Central Act II of 1879). Hence the Security Bonds executed need not be stamped.

XII. COMMUNICATION

32. All notices, notification and publications regarding admission to Super Speciality in Tamil Nadu Courses 2021-2022 session will be published on the official websites

www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in

www.tnmedicalselection.org

Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of information published on the websites.

33. (a) The candidates who join Super Speciality Courses should not indulge in any kind of agitation, strike or ragging activity inside and outside the college campus during the course of the study. Candidates found to take part in any such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course/college, at any part of the course of study and criminal action will be taken against them.

(b) The extract of letter / direction from MCI as per Letter No.MCI-34(1)/2014-Med (Ragg.)/130894, dated 11.09.2014 is given in Annexure V for information of candidates.

34. Any candidate applying for admission to Higher Speciality Courses 2021-2022 session is deemed to have read the contents in this Prospectus and agrees with all the conditions and clauses and will not have the right to challenge any of the clauses of this Prospectus.
