- > Method of all fee payments through online payment portal only.
- Candidates have to pay application fee through online via Debit card/Credit card/ Net Banking or RTGS.
- > All Candidates should make sure to apply in time and avoid last minute rush.
- Candidates must note that mere deduction of fee from the Bank account is not a proof of fee payment.
- (b) Service Candidates should upload their Service Particulars along with the online application
- 2. Online Applications which are submitted incomplete are liable for rejection without any intimation to the candidate.

ELIGIBILITYCRITERIA:

- 3. Candidates seeking admission to the M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Course should be a Citizen of India.
- 4. Candidates who have qualified from recognized Universities in Tamil Nadu in both Undergraduate and Post Graduate Degree courses only are eligible
 - a) The candidate who have obtained Master Degree in Social Work done under regular stream from a recognized University, specialized in Medical & Psychiatric Social Work.
 - b) The candidate must secure not less than 55% (for OC/BC/BCM/MBC/DNC) and 50% (for SC/SCA/ST/PWD) marks in the aggregate of the Masters Degree as a whole.
 - c) The candidates (specialized in Medical & Psychiatric Social work) working in Government Services are eligible to apply for M. Phil (Clinical Social Work)
 - d) Master Degree in Social Work done under regular scheme with specialization of Community Development, integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management from a recognized university are also eligible to apply for M. Phil (Clinical Social Work)

- e) Preference will be given to Master Degree in Social Works done under regular stream (specialized in medical and psychiatric social work) from a recognized institute.
- f) If there are no eligible candidates with master degree in social works done under regular stream (specialized in medical and psychiatric social work) obtained from a recognized institute, the candidates with specialization of Community Development, integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management obtained from a recognized university will be considered for M. Phil (Clinical Social Work)
- 5. The following categories will be treated as <u>Service candidates</u> for selection under the seats reserved exclusively for service candidates:

Candidates who have obtained Master Degree in Social Work (MSW), with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work, Master Degree in Social work with specialization in Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course (from a recognized University) post graduates serving in Tamil Nadu Medical Service on a regular basis and who have completed two years of service as on <u>31.07.2024</u>

PROCEDURE FOR FILLING THE ONLINE APPLICATION:

- 6. Candidates should upload the necessary enclosures while submitting the online application form.
 - a) SC/SCA/ST Candidates of Tamil Nadu Nativity are exempted from Application fee.
 - b) Recent Passport size photograph to be uploaded in the application form.
- 7. Candidates must upload the following documents along with the application, failing which the application is liable for rejection:
 - i) Master Degree in Social Work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization in Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course (from a recognized University) completion certificate from the College where the candidate had undergone the course.

- ii) Master Degree in Social Work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization in Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course (from a recognized University) Degree Certificate or provisional pass certificate from the University concerned to which the college is affiliate:
- iii) First year/ semester to final year/semester Master Degree in Social Work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization of Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course(from a recognized University) Mark sheets issued by the University concerned.
- iv) Transfer Certificate from the college where the candidate had undergone the course.
- v) Community Certificate issued by the competent authority from Revenue Department of Tamil Nadu with official seal and Date.
- vi) Birth Certificate or copy of Higher Secondary School Certificate / School Leaving Certificate / College Leaving Certificate.
- vii) Attempt Certificate in Final Year Master Degree in Social Work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization of Community Development in Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course (from a recognized University) from the College/University concerned.

Candidates are instructed to produce the above mentioned original Certificates/ Documents at the time of admission for certificate verification.

8. The Government Orders issued and to be issued from time to time pertaining to any of the matters contained in the prospectus should be read as part and parcel of this prospectus and such terms and conditions in the Government Order are deemed to have been incorporated in this prospectus.

MERIT LIST:

- 9. The merit list for admission of candidates for M.Phil (Clinical Social Work) Course will be made on the basis of total marks obtained by the eligible candidates in all the year / semester examinations of Master Degree in Social Work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization of Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course (from a recognized University) put together which is reduced to the base of 100 marks.
- 10. A common Merit List for the M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) course will be prepared by computing of academic marks for 100.

11. CALCULATION OF ACADEMIC MARKS: -

The total marks obtained must be reduced to the base of 100 marks and the weighted total marks obtained should be calculated accurate to two decimals. The academic marks is arrived at as shown below: -

Candidates, who have furnished the marks sheets only in grades, should furnish the actual marks obtained from the university. If not, only the minimum marks of the grade will be considered.

12. The Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the merit list in the websites: <u>www.tnmedicalselection.net</u> / <u>www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in</u>.

The candidates are advised to visit the websites every day from the date of issue of online application for information.

13. The candidates will be called for online counselling as per their merit and they may exercise their option as per the eligibility norms mentioned in the prospectus, availability of seats and communal reservation in force.

14. DETERMINATION OF INTER-SE-MERIT

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks out of a total of 100 marks, the inter se merit of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order of preference: -

- a) Least number of appearance in the final Semester of Master Degree in Social work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization in Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course Examination from a recognized University.
- b) Total marks obtained in the final year examination of Master Degree in Social work (MSW) with Specialization in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work / Master Degree in Social work with specialization in Community Development, Integrated social work, family and child welfare and human resource management course from a recognized University.
- c) Seniority in age will be given preference.

ONLINE COUNSELLING PROCEDURE:

- 15.(a) Admission to M.Phil (Clinical Social Work) course will be done by online counselling on the basis of merit applying the rule of reservation by Government of Tamil Nadu. The detailed online counselling procedure is available in annexure
 - (b) The candidates who have not registered and not choice locked in the 1st round of online counselling will be permitted to the subsequent rounds of online counselling.

- (c) Candidates who have not registered and not choice locked at the scheduled date and time of online counselling will not be considered for admission. However the Selection Committee reserves the right to permit the candidate to attend the subsequent online counselling, if a valid reason is communicated to the Selection Committee before the commencement of subsequent online counselling. The candidates permitted can be admitted only if seats are available at the time of subsequent counselling.
- 16. Candidates selected for admission should give a declaration in the form given at the time of admission that he / she is liable for forfeiture of selection / admission if suppression of facts are found at any time during or after admission to the course. The selection / admission shall be liable for cancellation based on the declaration at any time during or after the admission to the course. Further he/she will not be allowed to apply for the M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Degree Course for the succeeding Two Years.
- 17. The candidate should produce their original certificates in person at the time of joining in their selected institution /Medical college along with the photocopy of original certificates.
- 18. Any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available immediately on the websites (www.tnmedicalselection.net / www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in).

The candidates are instructed to frequently visit the website from the date of application till the end of online counselling without fail. All information including the date of online counselling will be available in the website.

METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

19.(1) The Selection will be made by ONLINE counselling based on merit applying the Rule of Reservation followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

The rule of reservation will be as follows: -

BC, BCM, MBC, DNC, SC, SCA & ST are eligible for selection under open competition as per merit in addition to the reservation made for them.

Within the 30% reservation for Backward Classes 3.5% reservation will be provided for Muslims.

16% of seats out of 18% Quota earmarked to Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyar Community as per Tamil Nadu Act No.4 of 2009 dated 12.03.2009.

- (2) (a) Any remaining unfilled seats for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to SCA community shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC community other than Arunthathiyar as per merit and vice versa. [G.O.(Ms.) No.55, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 08.04.2010.]
 - (b) Any remaining reserved seats in ST Quota for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to ST community shall be allotted to candidates belonging to SC Community as per merit. [G.O. (Ms.) No.77, Health & Family Welfare (MCA 1) Department, dated 24.02.2011.]
 - (c) Any remaining unfilled seats in BCM Community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled upon merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole. [G.O. (Ms.) No. 30, Health & Family Welfare (MCA 1) Department, dated:18.01.2012.]
 - (d) Even after filling up of the required seats reserved for Arunthathiyars on preferential basis, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, such excess number of candidates of Arunthathiyars shall be entitled to compete with the Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars in the inter-se merit among them [As per G.O.(Ms.) No.65, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (K) Department, dated 27.5.2009.]
- (3) i. 50% of seats are reserved for service candidates, in addition to those service candidates selected in the open category. In case an odd number seat remains, that seat shall be filled by merit and communal reservation.
 - ii. If there are no eligible Service candidates opting for M.Phil (Clinical Social Work) course, the same will be allotted to eligible Non-Service candidates and vice versa.

SPECIAL CATEGORY: -

SEATS RESERVED FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS:

- 20. a) 5% of the total number of seats available in Government Medical Institutions are reserved for the differently abled persons.
 - b) (i) Candidates with disabilities of 40-80% may be considered eligible.
 - (ii) Candidates with more than 80% disabilities NOT ELIGIBLE for reservation.
 - (iii) Candidates with less than 40% disabilities-NOT ELIGIBLE for admission.

Provided, the candidate belonging to 20(b)(ii) are not eligible to apply for the M.Phil (Clinical Social Work) course.

Provided, the candidate belonging to 20(b)(iii) are eligible to apply for the M.Phil (Clinical Social Work) under General Category.

The other conditions for admission into the course will be applicable as in the case of the general category. The candidates are required to produce a certificate from the Medical Board of the Medical Colleges of the area concerned constituted for this purpose assessing the nature and the extent of physical disability in the format prescribed in the Annexure–I(A&B).

The Certificate must have been obtained within three months prior to submitting the application for seeking admission under this category. If the certificate has been obtained earlier, the application will be rejected. The Medical Certificate issued by the District Medical Board of the area concerned for this purpose is subject to the confirmation of the Expert Committee constituted by the Director of Medical Education before online counselling.

The candidates seeking admission under this category should produce the full size photograph exhibiting the deformity. Seats earmarked for the special categories will be allotted following the Horizontal Reservation. If no eligible candidates are available for the seats earmarked under special category, those seats will be added to general pool and allotted on merit basis.

Note:-

- 1. The candidates who have applied under this category will be required to undergo a second Medical Examination by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Director of Medical Education to ascertain and confirm the nature and extent of Physical disability.
- 2. (a) Candidates with any other disability other than the loco motor disability of the lower limb will not be considered for admission to the course under this Special Category.
 - (b) Upper Limbs, Vision and Hearing should be normal.

The decision of the Director of Medical Education in this regard will be final

- 21. The candidates who are selected should pay the tuition fee in total prescribed in clause 23 through online banking payment portal via Debit card / credit card / net banking for downloading the allotment orders. After the receipt of the joining report from the Dean, Stanley Medical College, this amount will be transferred to the Institution. This fee is not refundable if the candidate discontinues or does not join the course.
- 22. All candidates attending the online counselling for M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Degree Course will have to remit a non-refundable amount of ₹. 500/- through online banking payment portal via Debit card/credit card/ net banking as Registration fee.

TUITION FEES, NUMBER OF SEATS, DURATION OF COURSE &

DISCONTINUATION FEE:

23.i. Tuition fee- ₹17,500/- per term.(Two terms/ year subject to revision).

- ii. No. of seats available-15 seats.
- iii. The duration of the M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) course shall be 2 Academic Years.

iv. Discontinuation fee:-

The students who are allotted and joined in any of the seats in Government Medical Colleges and discontinue the course after the cut-off date should pay the Discontinuation fee of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Secretary, Selection Committee, Director of Medical Education, Kilpauk Chennai 10" payable at Chennai.

The candidates who fail to remit the discontinuation fee will not be relieved from the course and the original certificates will be retained.

HEPATITIS-B VACCINATION:

24. All the Selected candidates for admission to the M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Degree course for 2024-2025 session should take Hepatitis–B vaccination and submit a medical certificate from an authorized Medical Officer as proof thereof, to the Head of the Institution at the time of joining.

Admission to the course will not be allowed by the Head of the Institution without the medical certificate. The candidate should take further doses at the prescribed intervals as required.

COMMUNICATION:

- 25. a) The Intimation can be downloaded from the websites: <u>www.tnmedicalselection.net</u> & <u>www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in</u> as per Instructions on Page 2 of this Prospectus. Selection Committee will not be held responsible for non-viewing of website.
 - b) Candidates should inform change of address, change of postings, etc., immediately to the Selection Committee. If the change of address is not intimated to the Selection Committee in time, the Selection Committee will not be responsible for delay in communication.
- 26. The candidates who join M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Degree Courses should not indulge in any kind of agitation /strike /ragging activity inside / outside the college campus during the course of study. Candidates found to be taking part in any such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course/college, at any point during the course of study and criminal action will be taken against them.
- 27. Candidates who have applied for M. Phil (Clinical Social Work) Course are deemed to have read the contents in the Prospectus and agree with all the conditions and clauses and will not have the right to challenge any of the clauses contained in this prospectus.
